

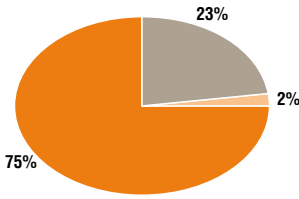

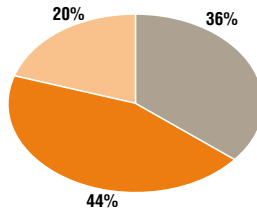
## KNOWLEDGE TRANSFER IS A PRIORITY

In 2010 the Centre hosted many international scientific conferences and organised several large-scale professional conferences: TAO Days (10-11 March 2010), World Metrology Day (20 May 2010), the International Conference on Strategic Management AIMS 2010 (2-4 June 2010), the 22<sup>nd</sup> French-language Conference on

Man-Machine Interaction (IHM'10, 20-23 September 2010), the ImageJ Conference (27-29 October 2010), the 5<sup>th</sup> Edition of the Congress on Project Management (18 November 2010), the 12<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the European Group for Lean Construction (24-26 November 2010), "Towards new perspective for a fair economy in

Luxembourg" (24 November 2010), the 4<sup>th</sup> Edition of the colloquium "On the way to Lisbon" (7-9 December 2010) and many others.

The options for degree-level training were extended by the addition of a fifth Master's degree programme, for which the first degrees will be awarded in 2011, the Executive Master's in Innovative Service Systems (EMISS). Finally, two new qualifying training cycles were developed: "Metrology" and, in collaboration with the International Space University (ISU) and the Groupement Luxembourgeois de Aéronautique et de l'Espace (GLAE), "Introduction to Space Business". Also worth a mention is the launch in collaboration with BGL BNP Paribas, Ernst & Young and ProCompany, of the Exchange<sup>2</sup>Innovate initiative. This initiative looks to pool the best innovative practices for strategy, process and technologies via in-company workshops in the Luxembourg region. ## TECHNOPORT® READY TO FLY THE COOP

In 2010, the discussions started in 2007 with the ministries of the Economy and Research with a view to transferring the Technoport® activities into a new national structure were picked up and should reach a conclusion in 2011. The pride of CRP Henri Tudor is the success of its incubator created in 1998.

Technoport® feels it is ready to fly the coop. In 2010 three new companies joined it. Clariance Sarl ([www.clariance.lu](http://www.clariance.lu)), SeeZam ([www.seezam.com](http://www.seezam.com)) and Intelli+ ([www.intelli-plus.com](http://www.intelli-plus.com)) bringing to 15 the number of start-ups currently under its roof, and

to 52 the total number hosted since its creation.

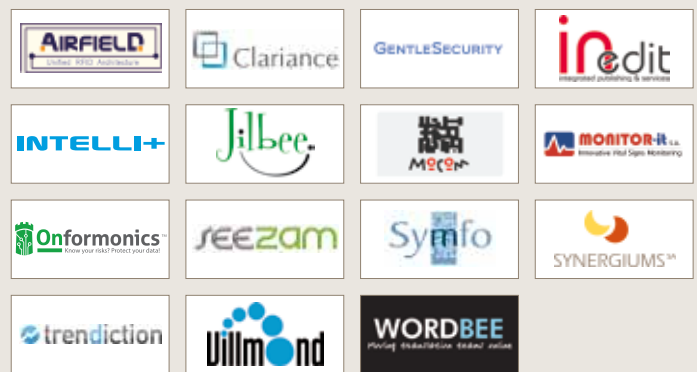
Codasystem SA ([www.codasystem.com](http://www.codasystem.com)) and Xintec SA ([www.xintec.com](http://www.xintec.com)), in their turn, left the incubator in 2010 as "success stories". In June 2010 Technoport® was elected to the Executive Board of the European Business Network ([www.ebn.eu](http://www.ebn.eu)), an indication of the recognition it enjoys at the European level. Technoport®'s expertise has been widely drawn on during 2010. Technoport® has coached businesses under the Fast Track Funding programme of the North Rhine Westphalia region, taken

part as a jury member in various events in the Eureka European Venture Contest and provided training to Jordanian entrepreneurs as part of a EuropeAid project. Finally, to help in its international development, in 2010 Technoport® became a member of the American National Business Incubation Association (NBIA) and took part in a trade mission of the Ministry for the Economy with a view to starting discussions on collaboration with incubators in the San Francisco area.
